Paul-John and the Chevrons

Release date: May 21st, 2018

From the ashes of the seasoned Louisville-based band, "Digby", arose a new approach from former frontman, Paul-John Moeller. In 2016, based in part on a late-night conversation and a humble recording experiment in his Butchertown home in Louisville, KY, Paul-John quietly released "Medicine's Medicine". The 10-song LP was loosely inspired by an obscure television medical drama, using imagery of physical and mental trauma as a common thread throughout the recording.

In the spring of 2018 comes Paul-John's latest self-produced project. "Paul-John and the Chevrons" was recorded again in his private studio throughout 2017, but this time with a much larger cast of musicians who signed on for the project. While still true to his unique sound, "Paul-John and the Chevrons" became a more organic and acoustic-based record. Those familiar with the Brit-rock inspired "Digby" will feel similar musical associations with this collection of songs, albeit with a new sense of cohesiveness to go along with the patina. Featuring elegantly driven and sometimes reverse beats with contemplative lyrics and soaring melodies, the songs, "**The Red Lights**", and "**Seashells by the Circuitry Seashore**" are among a few in this group that are lyrically inspired by the science-fiction novel "Fahrenheit 451" by Ray Bradbury, and the complicated internal struggle the main character, Montag, has in his relationship with his wife Mildred. In contrast, "**Clay**", one of the last songs to be finished in the studio, was actually based on a much older version of a song that had been written 12 years earlier under a different unreleased title. It found a voice once again with a new rapid staccato beat and bubbling bass melody.

Look for upcoming live dates in the summer and fall of 2018 as Paul-John and the Chevrons expands into your part of the universe.
